When: Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> April - Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> April

Time: 9.30am - 4.00pm

Cost £22 per day for bookings and payment received before 24<sup>th</sup> February. For forms received after then, there will also be a one off administration fee of £15 payable.

Please also note that places are allocated on a first-come-first served basis so even if forms are received by 2nd March we cannot guarantee a place.

Unfortunately individual funding is not available but some of the cost is claimable as part of the Working Tax Credit for those eligible.

A mini-bus service, will operate in the Wokingham and south/east Reading areas ONLY, There is an additional cost of £7 per day for transport.

We must emphasise places are very limited and will be confirmed after 2nd March.

We operate a high staff ratio with a minimum of 1 adult to 2 children or more as required.
