

Code of conduct



1. Be ready to learn...*what does this look like?*

- All staff expect students to be in class on time so they can actively participate in the lesson outcomes
- All students will aim for an independent approach to their learning and achievement of lesson targets
- All students will be held accountable for their actions through the progress sheets, reward and consequences system
- All students to wear College uniform of black trousers, Cranbury polo shirt and/or Cranbury sweatshirt
- Students to be supported by their parent/carer/keyworker so that they can learn
- All staff to ensure that lessons are planned effectively to engage students and help them learn and make progress

- Phones and other electronic devices must be handed in at reception on arrival

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2. Be respectful...*What does this look like?*

- We expect students to talk to each other and staff politely and with respect without the use of bad or personal language
- We expect students to resolve conflicts seeking resolutions and taking ownership of your part in any negative situations
- We expect parents and carers to support the college in any disciplinary actions that are taken
- We expect that all staff will have high expectations of student's behaviour and achievement
- We are all expected to respect the Code of Conduct and understand that rules are there to support and protect everyone

- Everyone is given the same opportunities to thrive
- We value and respect peoples cultural and religious differences

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3. Be safe...*what does this look like?*

- All students will follow the health and safety rules by not taking part in behaviour or activities that could harm themselves or others i.e. throwing objects, locking of doors, covering of CCTV, damage to property
- No drugs or students under the influence of drugs on site; this includes smoking on school premises.
- We do not tolerate any form of bullying; cyber, verbal, physical, racist, homophobic or cultural
- We expect parents/carers to pay for damage caused by unsafe behaviour and support the college in any disciplinary matters including the involvement of the Police
- We expect staff to follow health and safety procedures keeping students safe and using Team Teach training appropriately
