

Cranbury College can offer an interim service that can be for a period of 1-2 weeks; we would suggest any longer than that may need to be escalated to a respite provision. The purpose of the intervention is for a period of time out of school so they have time to reflect on their current behaviours and what they need to do to maintain their place on their return to you.

We only provide a timetable from 1-3pm daily, so schools are responsible for providing work to access at home if an alternative provision cannot be sort.

Cranbury Interim Service Provision will be separate from our normal timetable.

We would expect work to be sent over so that are not missing their education, but we will also cover the areas of concern with our intervention work.
